NOXIOUS WEED NOTICE TOWN OF JACKSON

Every person is required by law to destroy all the following noxious weeds as defined by Section 66.0407 of the Wisconsin Statutes on lands in the Town of Jackson, Washington County, Wisconsin, which the person owns, occupies or controls.

- 1. Canadian Thistle
- 2. Leafy Spurge
- 3. Field Bindweed (Creeping Jenny)
- 4. Any weed designated as a noxious weed by the Department of Natural Resources by rule, and any other weed the Town Board of the Town of Jackson or the County Board of Washington County by ordinance or resolution declares to be noxious within its respective boundaries:
 - a. Burdock
 - b. Garlic Mustard
 - c. Wild Parsnip
