RE: 2025 Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep Program

This memo is a reminder that Washington County continues to support a program to safely and cheaply dispose of Household Hazardous Waste and Agricultural Chemicals. Service to county residents is available Mondays and Wednesdays from 11:00am - 6:00pm, and Saturdays from 8:00am - 2:00pm (*February through December*). (registration will close December 1, 2025) County residents shall transport items to the Veolia Environmental Services disposal site in Menomonee Falls during these times. The cost is \$10/disposal and [registration](#) is required. (farmers must call ahead before drop off).

Full details on what will and will not be accepted, dates that you can take your items, hours of operation, and a map showing the location of the Veolia site. You will also find links to alternative disposal options for items other than hazardous waste.

Proof of registration and Washington County residency will be required at the Veolia entrance gate. Facility operators reserve the right to refuse any substance that cannot be disposed. Please pay close attention to what may or may not be disposed of as hazardous waste. Additionally, there is an exchange area where participants may choose to take home reusable materials such as cleaning or automotive products, paints/stains, and lawn & garden products free of charge.

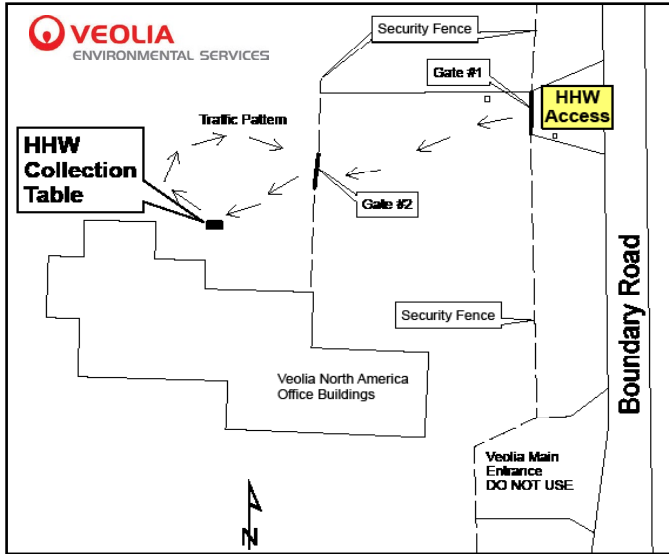

What to Expect Upon Arrival

1. Enter at "HHW Access" 2 blocks South of County Line Rd. Northern most entrance.
2. If Gate #1 is Closed press "Call" button, mention you have **hazardous waste**.
3. Drive slowly, follow cones & signs thru Gate #2.
4. Veolia staff will greet you at the collection table.
5. Provide registration receipt.
6. For fastest service & courtesy to others, pack items in boxes that can be recycled on site.

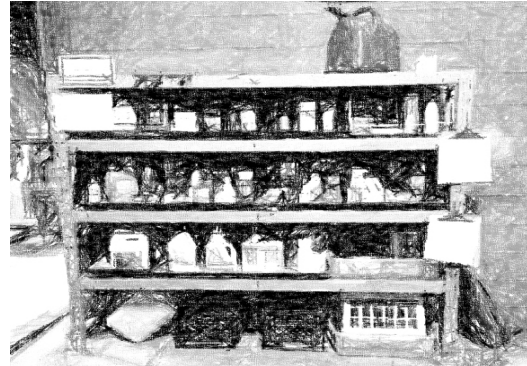
Important Disposal Information

- Veolia Facility operators reserve the right to refuse any substance that cannot be disposed.
- Participants will be checked against the registration database.
- Drop off materials **ONLY** during regular operating hours. Closed Holidays.
- Staff will **NOT** accept an expired receipt.
- **NO** appliances/white goods, computers, TVs, electronics or tires.
- **DO NOT BRING LATEX PAINT.**

Product Exchange Available

The product exchange shelf allows participants to take home usable materials, such as cleaning and automotive products, new or usable paints and stains, as well as lawn, garden and other household products at no additional charge.

- Materials and quantities will vary.
- *Liability waiver and release forms are required of product exchange participants.*
